The **maltman** SINGLE MALT Original Tasting Notes

Ardmore, 2010, 10 years old, 56,1%, sherry butt no. 1634 – NEU

Specially selected and bottled for Germany

*Nose: A lovely honeyed nose with some toasted oak, subtle smoke and cinnamon spice.
Palate: Creamy and warming with some spiced ginger, sherry notes and pear drops.
Finish: A warm finish with good length, some more sherry flavours, with chili chocolate, apricots and salted liquorice.*

Glen Spey, 1988, 32 years old, 43,8%, muscatel finish, cask no. 7005 – NEU

Specially selected and bottled for Germany

*Nose: Has some floral notes with hints of pear.
Palate: Is deliciously creamy with some ripe fruit, shortbread and milk chocolate.
Finish: Warming with peppery spice coming through. Let it breathe and some toasted oak and milky coffee notes appear.*

Secret Speyside, 2003, 16 years old, 54,1%, sherry butt no. 32100 – NEU

Specially selected and bottled for Germany

*Nose: A nice summery nose with floral hints.
Palate: Has a silk texture with warm honey. Sherry notes come through mid palate with some orange and toffee.
Finish: Chocolate covered raisins on the finish with roasted nuts. A mouth-coating dram, which is well balanced and warming.*
